



# Casey's Scholarship Program

---

## THE PROGRAM

Casey's General Stores, Inc. has established a scholarship program to assist employees' children who plan to continue their education in college or vocational school programs. Scholarships are offered each year for full-time study at an accredited institution of the student's choice.

This scholarship program is administered by Scholarship Management Services®, a division of Scholarship America®. Scholarship Management Services is the nation's largest designer and manager of scholarship and tuition reimbursement programs for corporations, foundations, associations and individuals. Awards are granted without regard to race, color, creed, religion, sexual orientation, gender, disability or national origin.

## ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must meet all of the following criteria:

- Be dependent\* children, ages 17 to 24, of part-time or full-time employees of Casey's General Stores, Inc. or one of its subsidiaries or affiliated companies (collectively, the "Company"). Part-time employees must have a minimum of five (5) consecutive years of employment with the Company as of the application deadline date. Full-time employees must have a minimum of two (2) consecutive years of employment with the Company as of the application deadline date.

*\* Dependent children are defined as children by birth, children by adoption, children by legal guardianship or stepchildren. In addition, children must be unmarried and meet **one** of the following:*

- *Be under age 19.*
  - *Be a full-time student ages 17 to 24 enrolled in an accredited education institution. Full-time student status continues during regularly scheduled school vacations and during extended absence for up to four months due to a disability or mental disability. A full-time student must be enrolled for a minimum of 12 credit hours or as otherwise defined by the educational institution.*
- Be high school seniors or current postsecondary undergraduates.
  - Plan to enroll in full-time undergraduate study at an accredited two-year or four-year college, university or vocational-technical school for the entire upcoming academic year.
  - Have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale, or its equivalent.

## AWARDS

If selected as a recipient, the student will receive a \$1,000 award. Up to twenty (20) awards will be granted. Awards are not renewable, however, students may reapply to the program each year they meet eligibility requirements.

Awards are for undergraduate study only.

---

## APPLICATION

Interested students must complete the application and mail it along with a current, complete transcript of grades to Scholarship Management Services postmarked no later than **March 1**. Grade reports are not acceptable. Online transcripts must display student name, school name, grade and credit hours earned for each course, and term in which each course was taken. Applicants will receive acknowledgment of receipt of their application. If an acknowledgment card is not received within three weeks, applicants may call Scholarship Management Services to verify that the application has been received.

Applicants are responsible for gathering and submitting all necessary information. Applications are evaluated on the information supplied; therefore, answer all questions as completely as possible. Incomplete applications will not be evaluated. All information received is considered confidential and is reviewed only by Scholarship Management Services.

---

### **SELECTION OF RECIPIENTS**

Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of academic record, demonstrated leadership, participation in school and community activities, honors, work experience, statement of goals and aspirations, and an outside appraisal. Financial need is not considered.

Selection of recipients is made by Scholarship Management Services. In no instance does any officer or employee of Casey's General Stores, Inc. play a part in the selection. All applicants agree to accept the decision as final.

Applicants will be notified of their award status in late April. Not all applicants to the program will be selected as recipients. Students may reapply to the program each year they meet eligibility requirements.

### **PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIPS**

Scholarship Management Services processes scholarship payments on behalf of Casey's General Stores, Inc. Payment is made in one installment on August 15. A check is mailed to each recipient's home address and is made payable to the school for the student.

---

### **OBLIGATIONS**

Recipients have no obligation to Casey's General Stores, Inc. They are, however, required to notify Scholarship Management Services of any changes in address, school enrollment, or other relevant information and to send a complete transcript when requested.

---

### **REVISIONS**

Casey's General Stores, Inc. reserves the right to review the conditions and procedures of this scholarship program and to make changes at any time including termination of the program.
